

Passion Project

For this project, you will research something that you are passionate about. **You are required to use a minimum of six sources to complete your research: two books, two articles, and two online websites.**

Web Page (100 pts.)

To complete this project, you will need to create a web page on your Online Portfolio (Google Sites). Call the page “Passion Project.” This page will include the following five sections.

Section 1: Introduction

Section 2: Historical/Cultural Background

Section 3: Personal Connection

Section 4: Free Section

Section 5: Significance

To complete these five sections, you will need to develop a minimum of ten driving questions (two questions per section). These questions will guide your research. Your discoveries will be shared with a general audience. Within the five sections, you are required to build five hyperlinks¹ that take your audiences to relevant images and or websites.

Sample Questions:

- What is my passion?
- Who or what got me into it?
- Why am I passionate about this topic?
- Where did it originate?
- How popular is my passion?

PowerPoint (50 pts.)

As part of the Passion Project, you will need to create a PowerPoint presentation and upload it to your Online Portfolio.

Requirements for Presentation:

- 8-10 slides
- 5 images
